GUIDELINES FOR ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING ON STUDENTS' LEARNING IN MARIA IMMACUALTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE, DUNMANWAY MAY 2020



Students in Irish schools have experienced a very disrupted period of learning in 2019/20 because of the unprecedented nature of the Covid-19 crisis. In MICC we have continued with learning and teaching through our online platforms. This has not been easy for anyone but we do appreciate the patience and understanding being shown during this time.

As a result of the crisis we have had to re-shape our end of year assessments for this summer across all of our year groups. A number of factors have fed into this:

- Students and teachers access to online platforms
- The wellbeing of all of our students and their families.

The comment will be based on the teacher's professional knowledge of each student's learning.

We appreciate that this is a change to the normal practice of assigning a percentage grade but in light of the exceptional circumstances we find ourselves in, we feel that it is in the best interests of students, their families and teachers.
